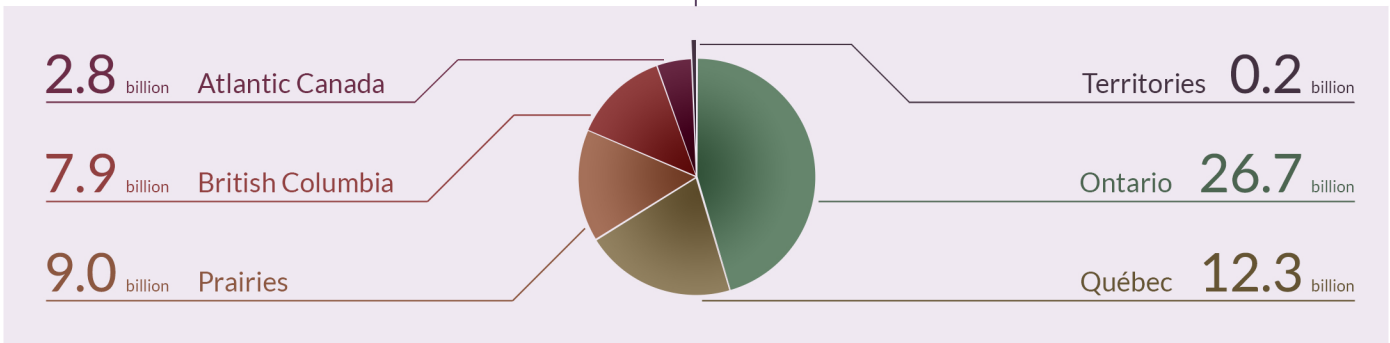
THE REGION AT A GLANCE

The performance of the cultural sector in the Territories has been mixed in recent years with gains in **Sound Recording** and **Heritage and Libraries** offset by reductions in other domains.

While the economic footprint of the sector accounts for over **\$224 million in GDP**, more than 50% comes from non-core cultural domains including **Multidomain, Education and Training, Governance, Funding and Professional Support**.

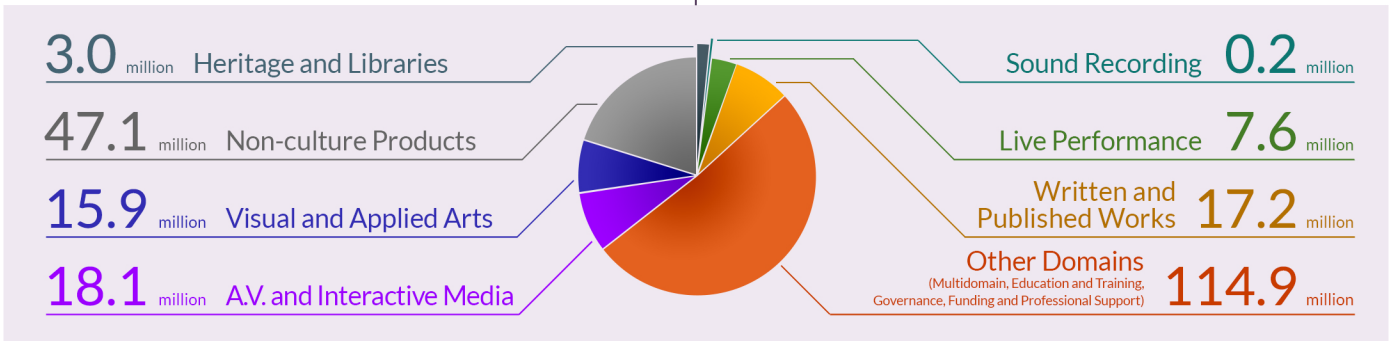
Fortunately, aside from a struggling **Visual and Applied Arts** domain, growth in the GDP associated from other cultural domains should help **expand the overall size** of the region's sector in the years ahead.

BREAKDOWN OF CULTURAL SECTOR GDP BY DOMAIN (\$ MILLION)

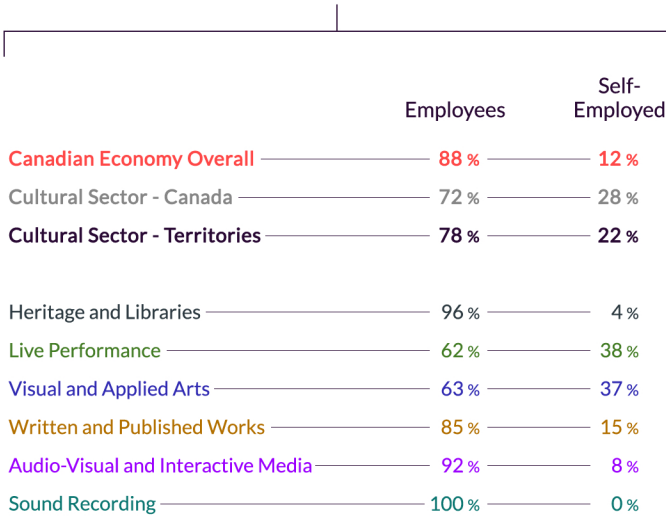

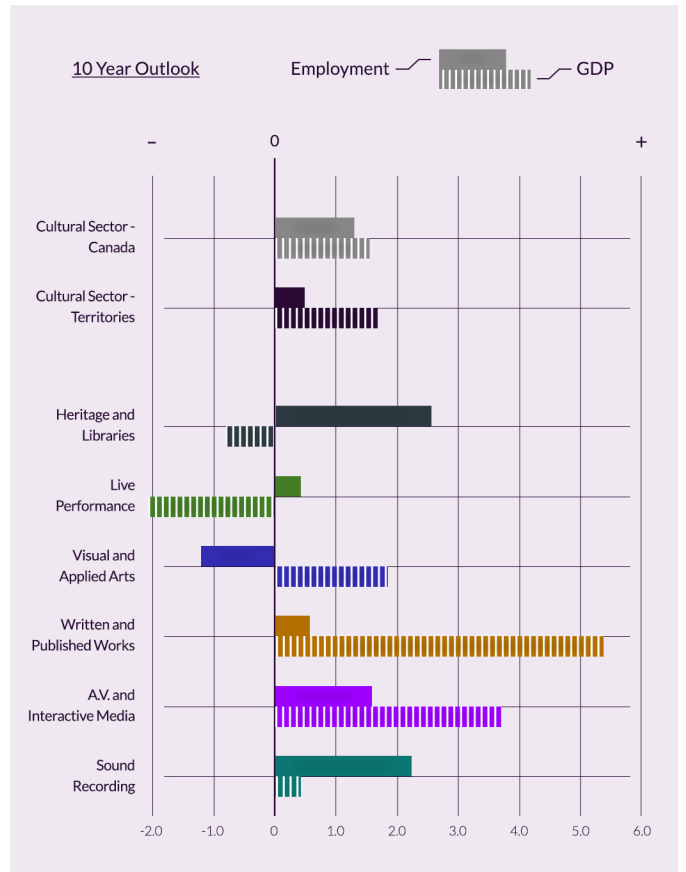
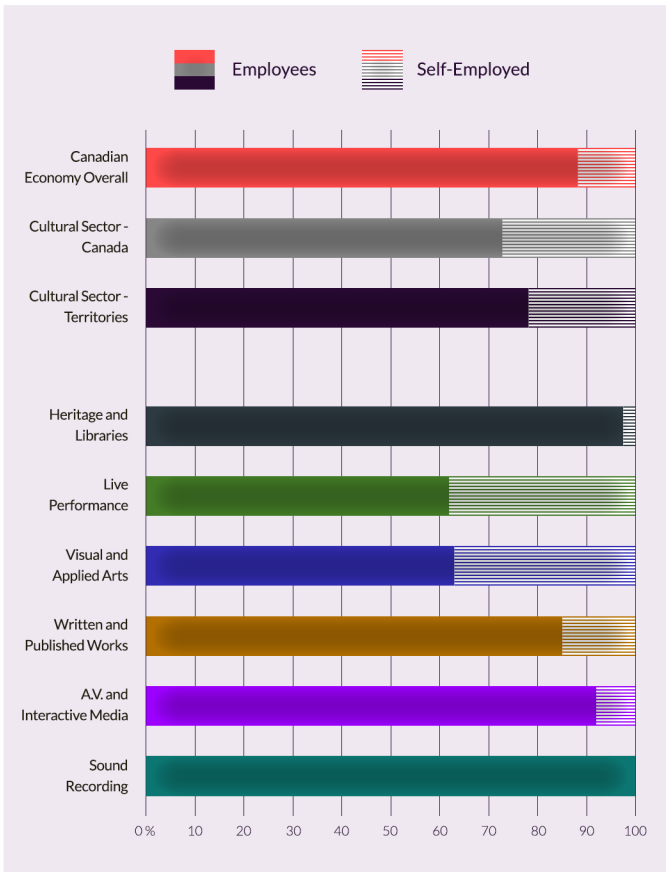
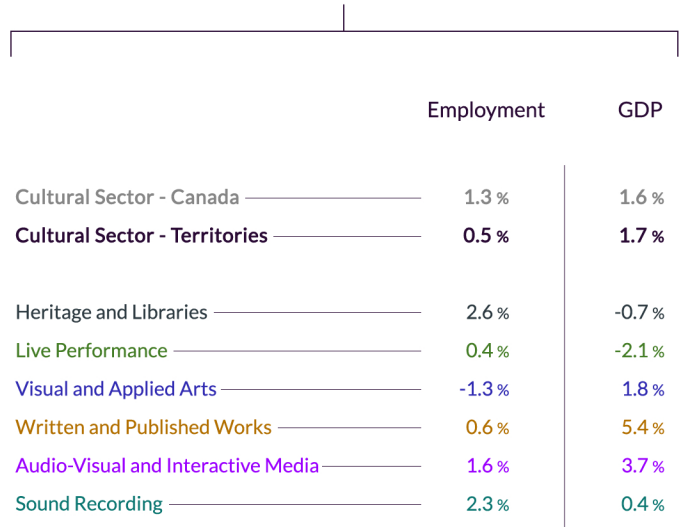
EMPLOYMENT STATUS

10-YEAR OUTLOOK BY DOMAIN (% AVG. ANNUAL INCREASE)



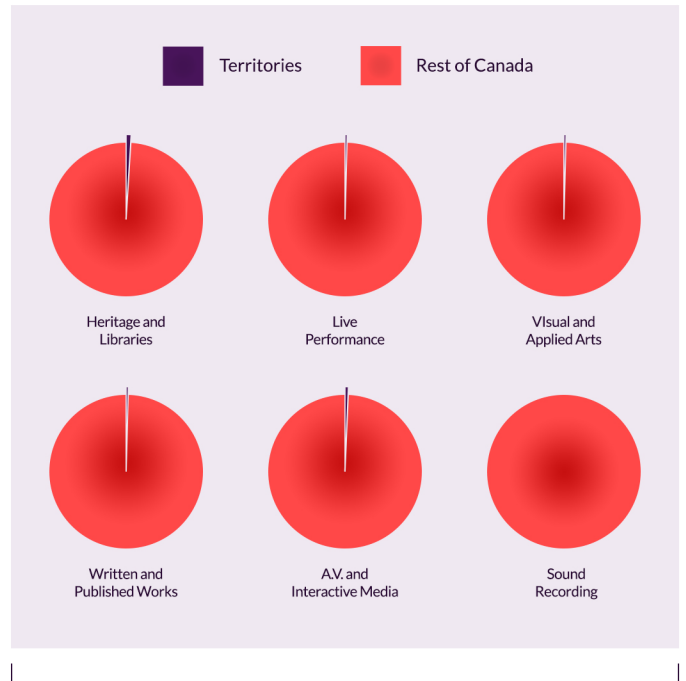
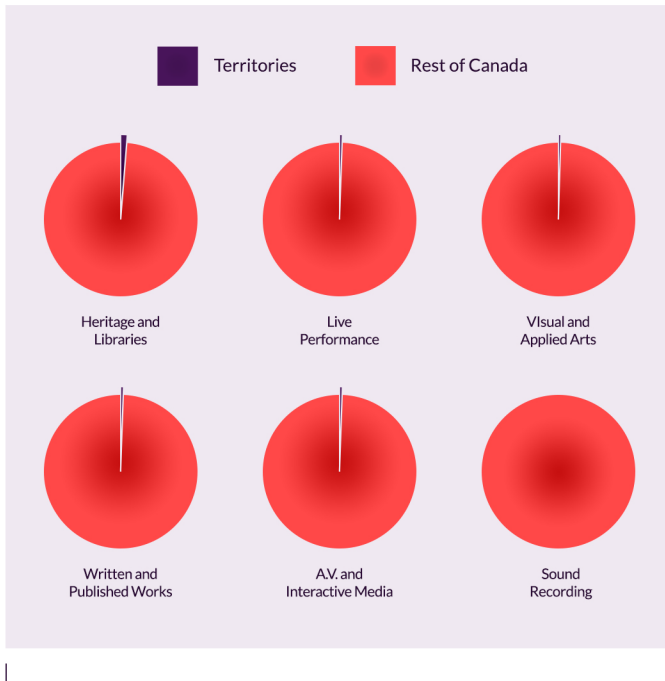
